Today's scientific work of the **Polish Academy of Arts and Sciences Krakow** is focused mainly on Commissions' and Subcommissions' work. There are more than twenty subject Commissions in different Classes and all of them publish their own series of *Works*, periodicals or other publication series according to their respective specialties. The result is a serious [publishing activity](#): dozens of volumes yearly.

The PAU owns important elements of scientific background for humanistic research. The [Library](#), completed since nearly 200 years, include many exceptional historical and scientific materials, among them newspapers and journals of 19th and 20th century as well as old prints, manuscripts, graphics and drawings. The [Archives](#), that origins also go back to the Cracow Learned Society, is an invaluable source for history reasearchers. Lately, as the result of agreement with the Historical and Literature Society in Paris, the PAU got back its rights to [the Polish Library collection](#). At present the reorganization works of this so meritorious for Poland institution are in progress.
